We had a quote on some remediation of the building behind the Library – it appears to be very comparable to the same amount it took to just completely demolish and remove the other building that was on this property. Do we really want to pay to remediate, find someone to take it and then wait until they finally do or should we just demolish it ourselves.

The board felt the Town should just demolish the structure. Mrs. Thompson will get the electric shut off and removed and call regarding dumpsters – hopefully, Dave Woods will be able to volunteer his time next month to take it down.

Mrs. Thompson reminded the board that the Town still needs to be thinking about the Dog kennels – we are NOT a shelter or adoption place. These are strictly to hold a dog until the SPCA can take it and from discussions with the SPCA, they will do everything within their power to make space available when they know there is one to be brought up, except for dangerous dogs. Something needs to be in place – the new DCO may have some ideas regarding this also and we can continue to discuss, but at some point, we need to get it done. Even if the new police building is not an option and honestly, that project itself looks like it won't be done until closer to next year anyhow. We have a deadline that the kennels would need to be in place before mid-December so we can fall under or be grandfathered under current regulations, because Janet at Ag & Mkts has informed us that if it does not get implemented until next year, there will be more scrutinizing regulations that may be impossible for us to meet. The current location is not acceptable. The county is STILL holding meetings and is searching for a more permanent solution for all the Towns in Essex County as we are ALL in the same situation. Please be thinking about this.
