


Q1 What are your main reasons for choosing to live here? (Check all that apply)




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

Q3 What cultural assets do you value the most?



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




Q16 To what extent do you believe the Town should encourage or discourage the following uses?



You built this to attract visitors and improve the community culture but there isn't a centralized or interactive way to promote it. Most recently, the town planned a great calendar of events and activities celebrating the Fall season on multiple dates but it was communicated on two flyers as a jpeg. This is hard to read on a cellphone screen, wasn't divided up by the day but was a list of all dates on one sheet, had no link to a web page that could be shared on social media or for more information, and was released too late to attract advance bookings to the town for tourists. I understand these events were primarily for the community residents but tourists can also impact the financial success these events have as revenue for the towns small businesses, which are owned by community residents. Recently I was on the town's chamber website and events that had already passed was still listed. I had to scroll through to find current and future events. I wanted to know what was on the calendar because I'm engaged, but most people will leave the page thinking it's a waste of time and not return. I feel that the Ticonderoga 360 website had focus in the beginning but now is not utilized at all. In this survey you provided a list of parks. Where online can people see this list with amenities/experiences available? My "big idea" is to focus much more attention on marketing what the town is doing more efficiently and effectively (which isn't a big idea, but a time consuming but essential component). Lead time to promote is essential (3 months out should be a goal), making it shareable for Facebook, Instagram, etc. that will work on a cellphone screen and a laptop/computer, stop the PDF/Jpeg flyers and make info linkable via a webpage. Have a marketing plan that is short term and long term with each program the town develops that is equally prioritized as its execution. I personally don't feel "if you build it, they will come." I think proactive, well planned marketing results in a program's success because of the exposure you get on what you built and inspires engagement on what is happening next. 

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Q28 What best describes your relationship with the Town of Ticonderoga? Select all that apply.



Q29 How long have you lived in Ticonderoga?







Q33 How many children under the age of 18 currently live in your household?



Q34 Where do you work in relation to your residence?




