

# Ticonderoga Water Meter Project



Dear Residents of Ticonderoga,

The State of New York, in 2019, issued an updated Water Withdrawal Permit to the Town of Ticonderoga, which requires us to install water meters on all residential and commercial properties receiving water from the town's water supply system. On April 16, 2026, we will have two informational meetings, in the Community Building, to provide an overview of the project timeline and answer questions from the community. 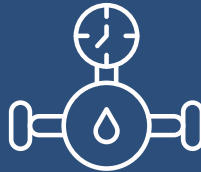

## Project Overview

- In April 2019, the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation issued an updated Water Withdrawal Permit to the Town of Ticonderoga.
- The permit requires the Town to establish and implement a water meter program to support water conservation and reduce usage.

What is a water meter?

- A device that measures the amount of water used by a home, business or facility.



## What to Expect

- Water meters will be installed on each water service (commercial and residential).
- Access is needed to the existing water service entering each building.
- Town will conduct informational workshops to provide more details prior to meter installation.
- Town Representatives will contact you to schedule appointments for meter installation.
- Water meter installation is expected to occur 2026-2027.

### Water Conservation

Will assist in water conservation and reduce waste.



### Billing Accuracy

Allow for accurate billing of water used.



### Locate Leakage

Will enable the Town to determine and locate leakage.




### Regulatory Compliance

In compliance with applicable laws, regulations and standards.
