

Gore Regional School Program (Saturday's) 2024-2025

Welcome all program schools! Once again, we are offering a ski/ride program for your school/town for the 24-25 season.

While the program is open to all students of all levels, ages 7-18, to ski/ride for 6 weeks, LESSONS are only available for levels 1-3 skiers & snowboarders. That means first time students and those thru the novice level will be able to take lessons in the weekend program. All other participants, levels 4+, can ski/ride on their own for the day, each week for the 6-wk program.

The lessons are 1 hr. in duration, from 8:30 - 9:30. Lessons meet at 8:15, on the gondola side of the Northwoods Lodge.

Lift tickets will be valid for the entire day, so after their lessons end at 9:30 they can ski/ride the remainder of the day. Those not taking lessons can ski/ride all day.

The dates for the Saturday Program are:

- January 4th, 11th, 25th February 1st, 8th, 22nd
- *Please note this program will not run on MLK Weekend or the first weekend of Presidents Week

Students participating in the Gore Regional School program must still be enrolled in your local school system, as in the past.

Registration deadline to submit to Gore is December 6, 2024.

All students will be receiving new passes this season (unless they are season pass holders). Passes will require a photo on the student's account. Parents can email their child's photo, along with full name, school name, and 'GRS program' to: sp@goremountain.com, or they may come to Gore Mtn Box Office, and we'll take their photo, 8:00 - 4:00, 7 days week, prior to Dec 6, 2024.

Additional info:

We will have a different sign up this year compared to years past. Parents will sign their children up through a specialized web portal created specifically for your town or school. This will allow the parents to sign the student up for the specific program they wish to participate in, as well as select if they will need rentals or not. This site looks like a store, but all the prices are set at \$0. It will be up to the town or school to track which students have signed up for the program and exactly how much they will need to pay. The town or school will be billed the same way as in years past. Parents will be asked to sign an Assumption of Risk agreement for their child before they are allowed to complete the sign-up process. This should save us from the issues we had last season regarding the Assumption of Risk agreements. Because of this change we will not be able to allow any late sign-ups this season as the web stores have a hard end date. A separate document will be included to share with parents to help them navigate the new sign-up process.

Students who are already season pass holders will need to fill out a paper application like in years past as unfortunately that option is not available through our web sign up process yet.

On program days, each child must check in at our 'check-in' tent, by Northwoods Lodge, near the rental shop doors.

For every 10 participants in your program, your town/school will receive 1 complimentary lift ticket each week. These comp tickets are to be check-in folks that will be available at lesson check in, to meet students when lessons are over, as well as available to your students throughout the day for any issues.

In addition to the complementary lift tickets, discounted chaperone tickets will also be available for purchase at a specified rate of \$82, like in the past. These chaperone tickets are limited to 5 for each school.

A list of all chaperone names should be submitted to Gore prior to the start of your program. Then, each week on Thursday before that weekend, please send the specific names of the 5 people who will be purchasing the chaperone ticket that weekend needs to be emailed to Chris, our Box Office Supervisor <u>csiracusa@goremountain.com</u>.

We look forward to having your school/town participate in our program this season.

- One registration form may be submitted for each family. All information is required and incomplete forms will be rejected.

 All purchases final. NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: SICKNESS, INJURY, HEALTH PROBLEMS, WEATHER CONDITIONS, NATURAL
- Age as of date of application determines eligibility. Proof of age required.
- We will use your existing file photo if we have one. Otherwise you may come to Gore any day prior to 1/04/25 between 9am and 3pm to have your photo taken. You can pick up your Passes at the Snow Sports Desk in the Northwoods Lodge on the first day of your program. Gore Mountain reserves the right to reject online file photos.
 - An RFID pass will be issued to each participant. This identification pass, property of Gore Mountain, serves as a permanent lift ticket for all scheduled days of 'n
- If the identification pass is lost or stolen you must notify Gore Mountain at once. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged to process a new pass. A one-day ticket will be issued ONLY one time during the season for a lost or forgotten pass. A fee of \$5 per day/ticket will be charged for subsequent forgetfulness for forgotten passes only. the program. This pass must be clearly presented to the Ticket Checker/Scanners on every lift boarding occasion. ó
 - Passes are non-transferable, are for the applicant's exclusive use and may be revoked if used by someone else.
- Ski area regulations are enforced by the reckless skier policy and New York State Code Rule 54, Article 18, "Safety In Skiing Code." Any misuse, fraudulent use, misconduct or nuisance caused by the pass holder or failure to follow New York State law or ski area policy may result in recall of the pass without refund or other consideration. Gore Mountain management
- reserves the right to recall passes depending upon the severity of rules infractions.

 9. A parent or legal guardian of persons under age 18 must complete and sign the registration on reverse side. An email will be sent to parent with link for parent's E-signature for the Pass Terms & Conditions and Assumption of Risk Agreement
 - 10. All dates, rates and provisions are subject to change without notice.
- 11. For the entire term of this pass, I relinquish my right to a refund of the purchase price of the pass purchased that is allowable under the Safety in Skiing Code for those persons unwilling to ski because of the risks of the sport or the duties imposed upon skiers by law.
